

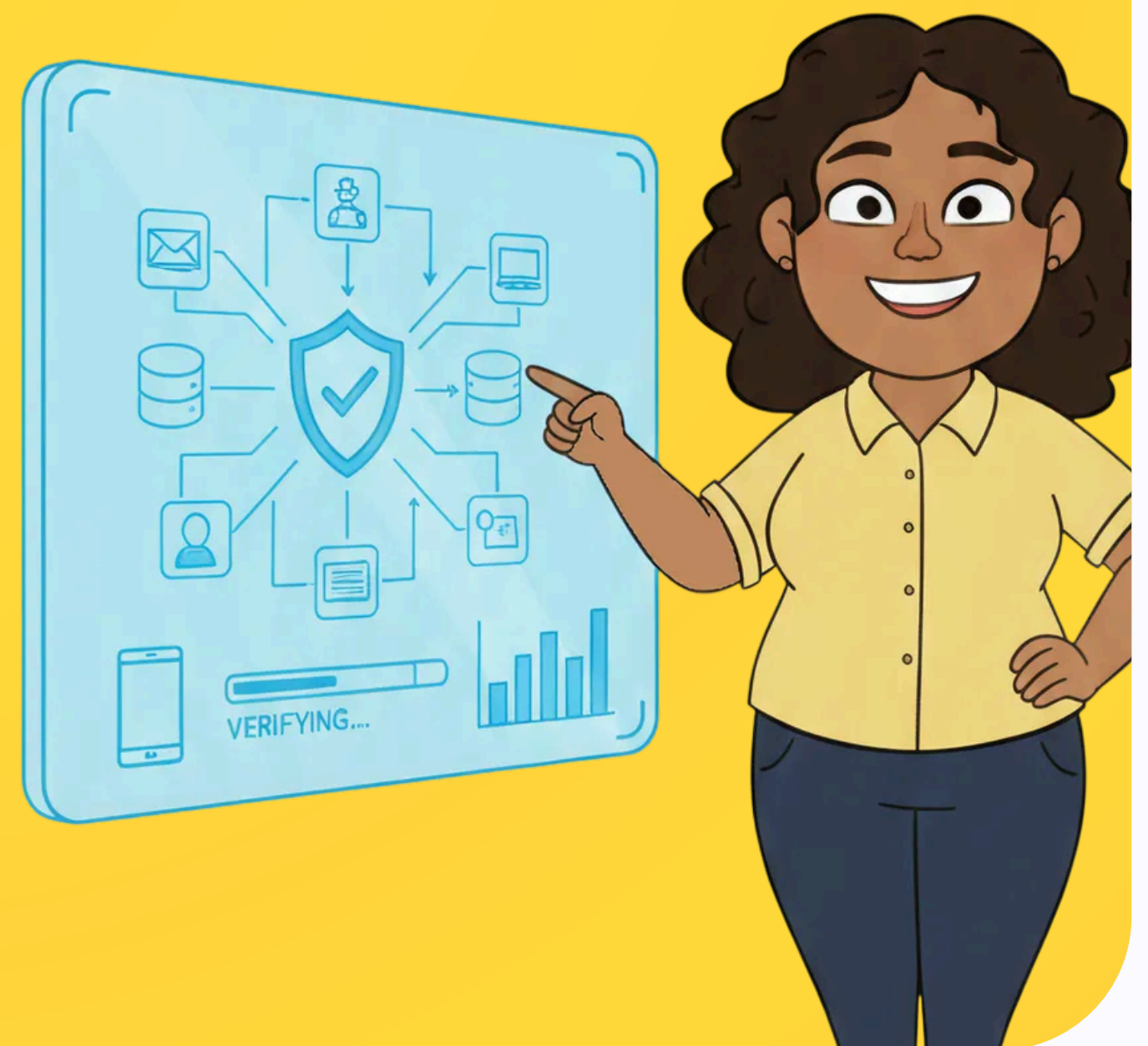


How to Build A Security Awareness Training Program

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Kick off training at onboarding.

Make it personal - show employees how security protects them, not just the company. Avoid the “check-the-box” trap - real awareness is continuous, not once a year.





Get Buy-In from the Top and Bottom

- Show leadership how security ties to business goals.
- Empower employees by turning influencers into ambassadors.
- If no one believes in it, no one will follow it



Make Training Simple, Real, and Useful

- Ditch the tech jargon & use real-life stories
- Keep it short (1-minute videos work best)
- Refresh content regularly to stay relevant



Focus on Behavior Change

- Meet people where they are (mobile-friendly, easy access)
- Use personal relevance. Teach scams they see at home
- Help them protect their family, and they'll protect your company
