Start with the Basics

- Back up your data
- Install antivirus on all devices
- Use strong, unique passwords – no sharing, no reuse
- Lock down computers with limited permissions



Control Internet & Device Access

- Limit who can access the internet
- Only connect essential devices
- Use a VPN if you're working remotely



Patch, Scan, and Protect

- Keep all apps and systems updated
- Scan for vulnerabilities before attackers do
- Use an email security gateway to block threats early

Train Your People (It's Non-Negotiable)

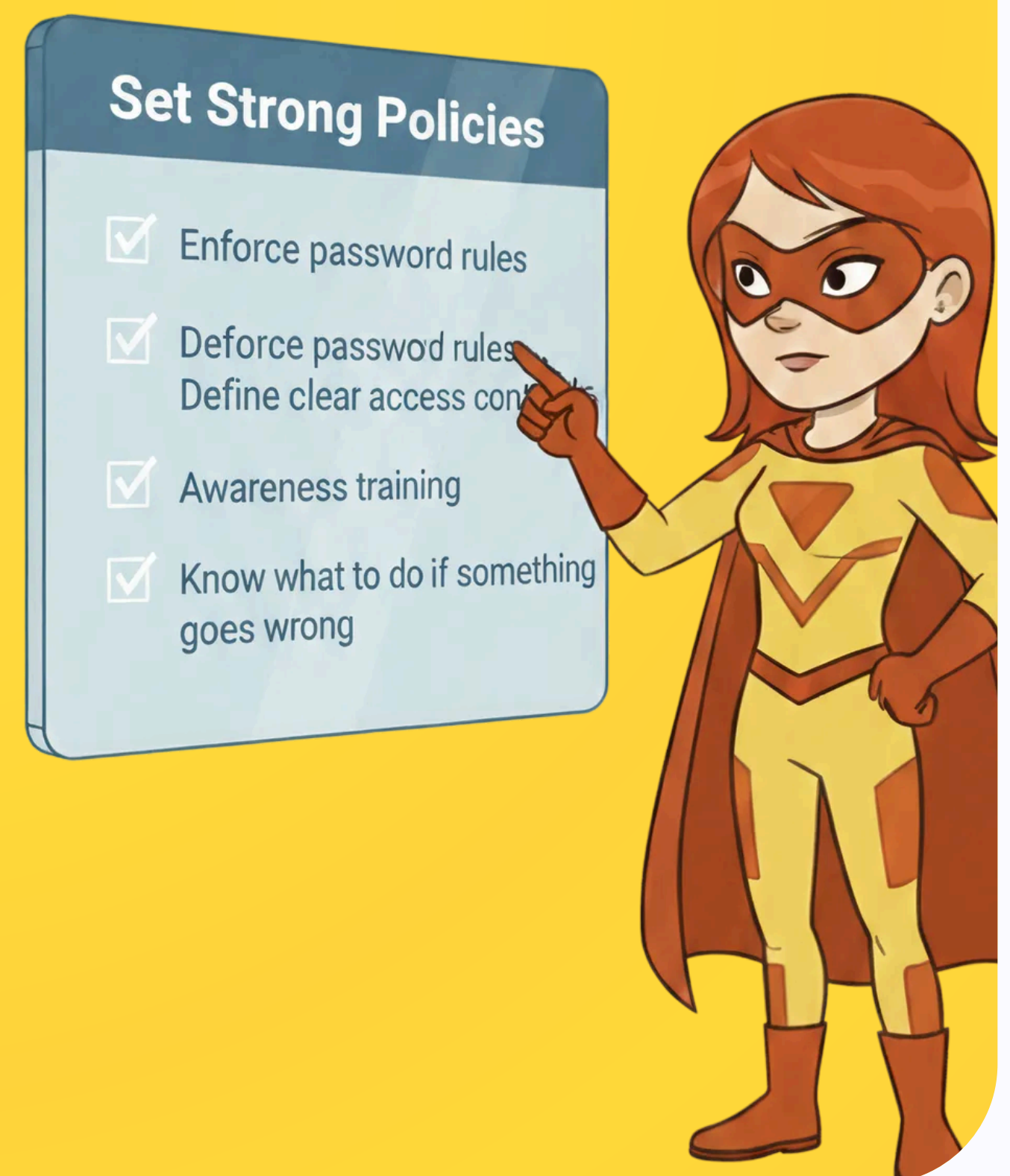
Your team is your first line of defense. Train them regularly, not just once a year. Security awareness isn't optional anymore.

- Enforce password rules
- Define clear access controls
- Know what to do if something goes wrong
